from all over the world, welcoming two million visitors every year.

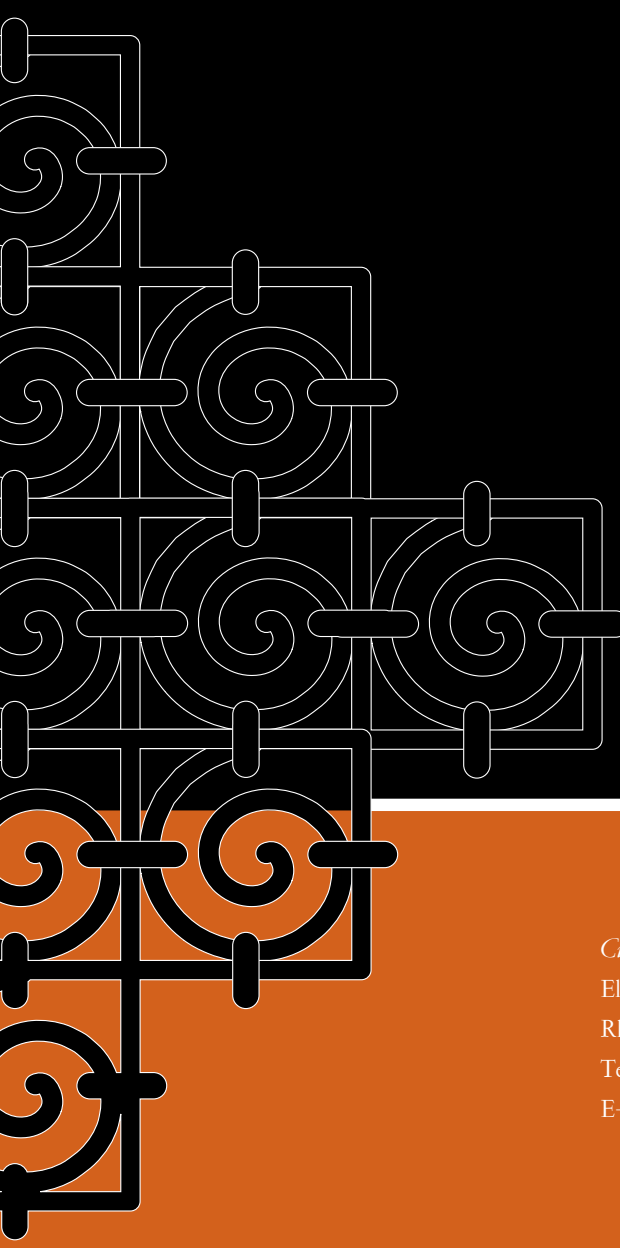
